Pastor's Report

The Commemoration of Spring and Hope

First, thank you so much for giving Debbie and Myself the opportunity and privilege to be among you to serve Svea congregation as your Pastor. You have warmly welcomed us and encouraged us. We are grateful for your support and prayers as we move forward.

May is an important and meaningful month in the life of the Church and Svea Lutheran Congregation. In addition to the weekly church services we will observe Pentecost Sunday on May 19th. This is a Red Banner Day in the Christian Church. The name comes from the Greek word pentekoste which means fifieth. It is the 50th day after the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. It is a special day because it is the beginning of the Christian Church. Jesus promised that He would not leave us alone as He was making preparation to Ascend to Heaven to be with the Father. Therefore, He gave the gift of the Holy Spirit with the command to go forth and "Make Disciples of All Nations"! The Holy Spirit is symbolized by wind, the first breathe of creation, secondly, fire to represent to believers enthusiasm replacing our fears with courage and the dove which symbolizes Peace that comes with the presence of the Holy Spirit. To commemorate this day on May 19th, please wear something Red.

Importantly as well on May 19th, we will be receiving new members into the Congregation of Svea Lutheran. The Church Council has approved the potential members and we will welcome them into the fold. At 9:30 AM that morning, the new members and their families along with the congregation are invited to the Fellowship Hall for a reception and welcome. Beginning that Sunday, the regular church service will be held at 10:30 AM and thru out the Summer months. Please say and extend a welcome to the New Members. We also want to congratulate Tucker Swanson upon his graduation from Willmar High School and wish him well. In memorium and respect, we remember and acknowledge Tucker's classmate who died last May and would have graduated with Tucker and his class. To his parents, Mike and Patti, His Brothers, Zachery and Jacob and Grandparents and extended family, please know that we have and will remember you in our prayers and thoughts.

Finally, and importantly, our Nation pauses on Monday May 27th to observe Memorial Day which before 1970 was known as Decoration Day because the Women of the North and South began to go to cemeteries and place flowers on the graves of the fallen soldiers who had died in the Civil War. In 1971 it became a Federal Holiday for us

as citizens to pause, attend Memorial Services and spend time at our Nation's cemeteries to honor and give thanks for all who have served our Country in time of War and have given their life to protect freedom and liberty which we are granted.

So, May is an important and vital month as Christians, members of Svea and for our Nation. For each of these events and occasions, we ask for and solicit your prayers and support.


These kits were assembled at the Friends in Faith event after worship on April 28th and will be delivered to the Lutheran World Relief shipping warehouse in St. Paul later this month.
